

# TEEN MAZE Frequently Asked Questions

## 1. Q: What is TEEN MAZE?

A: TEEN MAZE is an event for all Troup County 9th graders. With the help of professionals and community volunteers, students get to experience real consequences to real situations they may face. The goal of TEEN MAZE is to encourage teens to THINK before engaging in risky behaviors

## 2. Q: Can students that are not in the 9th grade participate in TEEN MAZE?

A: NO. As an event collaborated through Troup County School System, we are only approved to allow 9th grade students to participate at this time.

## 3. Q: Can students volunteer for TEEN MAZE?

A: NO. Students who are a part of Troup County School System cannot serve as volunteers at this time.

## 4. Q: I have volunteered in the past. Do I have to fill out all of the forms again including the Background Check?

A: YES! Each year volunteers will need to fill out a new volunteer packet. However, current employees of Troup County School System DO NOT need to fill out the Background Check and Volunteer Protocol.

## 5. Q: What topics do you cover at TEEN MAZE?

A: We cover several topics including abstinence, pregnancy, STDs, alcohol and drug use and domestic partner violence.

## 6. Q: How are station assignments made for volunteers?

A: Several factors determine where volunteers are placed including profession, volunteer time, and expressed preference. Though every effort is made to make our volunteers ☺, sometimes a volunteer may have to be reassigned the day-of as necessary to ensure that all areas are covered.

## 7. Q: Do I have to pay for the background check?

A: NO. Just fill the form and return to us.

## 8. Q: Is there a Parent/Community Preview Night this year?

A: NO. There will not be a Parent/Community Preview this year.
